What do we do?

Our activity consists in the production and dissemination in schools, universities and villages of documentaries in all African languages and dialects, and of information material that demonstrates how the experience of the dangerous crossing to Europe to change their fortunes often leads to tragic consequences, and how the dream of well-being and easy wealth is only a dangerous mirage, thanks also to the testimony of people who have experienced it directly.

Casa Africa also takes care of organizing and delivering training courses for immigrants with the aim of teaching them a trade, a job, partnering with artisan, industrial, commercial and tourist companies in Italy, in order to facilitate entry into the job market and in society, also thanks to the teaching of the Italian language.



What makes us unique?



Among the objectives of our organization, there is also being able to start training courses in Africa as soon as possible for medical and paramedical personnel, also thanks to the help of volunteer doctors and to be able to build first aid clinics with trained personnel.

Particular attention will also be paid to raising awareness among the populations with reference to the harmful practice of infibulation for girls, and to circumcision for children, which must take place in compliance with hygienic and sanitary conditions.

Our presence in the territory

The aim of our social work has is taking care of the poorest, of those who live in the shadow of our city, ignored by a fast world where individuality counts.

Today we try to intervene by lending support to the homeless, people in economic and social difficulties who, due to the crisis and personal or health problems, have given up being part of this world and remain waiting for the passage of time.



The benefits of investing in social projects



Carrying out charitable activities requires an investment of time and resources whose sole purpose is to propose real short-term solutions to counter situations of social or economic hardship.

We could never understand what lies behind each individual case, but we can certainly propose an alternative or a temporary remedy to those who are abandoned by society.

Poverty is not a condition of life that people choose to have, no one decides to be poor, but it is the circumstances that lead man to lose confidence in society and progressively not to believe in himself.

Poverty has no religion, ethnicity, age or sex, it is the maximum expression of the failure of a social system.

Our social activities are carried out with a careful eye on the role of cultural activities, which are an important driver for facilitating the inclusion and success of our social activities to protect the people in need.
